At vero eos et accusam et justo duo dolores et ea rebum.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ut wisi enim ad minim veniam, quis nostrud exerci tation ullamcorper suscipit lobortis nisl ut aliquip ex ea commodo consequat.</li> </ul>	<b>Post-Print (Important!)</b> <p>One last note on the poster and its margins, and how to trim the paper after printing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For A0, there should be a 20mm margin to the left, the right and the top, and a 50mm margin at the bottom (each measured from the thin gray frame).</li> <li>• For A1, divide those measurements by <math>\sqrt{2}</math>, ie. about 14mm at the top, left, and right, and 35mm at the bottom.</li> </ul> <p>The 20mm (or 14mm) correspond to the margin of the content (ie. the space between the thin gray line and the content of the poster). If they should be put up on the wall (with those aluminum frames), add 20mm at the top and the bottom (for both sizes).</p>
